ORDINANCE NUMBER 25-01

OF THE RICHARDSON BAY REGIONAL AGENCY AMENDING THE RICHARDSON BAY REGIONAL AGENCY CODE

WHEREAS, it is the intention and responsibility of the Board of Directors of the Richardson Bay Regional Agency (Board) to make decisions affecting the future of Richardson Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Board aims to promote safety in Richardson Bay for persons on and off anchored vessels; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that best practices in other California jurisdictions includes basic occupancy requirements for overnight anchoring; and

WHEREAS, the Board aims to proactively improve its stewardship of Richardson Bay.

In consideration of the foregoing, the Board of Directors of the Richardson Bay Regional Agency does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Adoption.

The Richardson Bay Regional Agency Code, Section 3.04.010 is hereby amended to read as set forth in Attachment 2.

Section 2. California Environmental Quality Act.

This ordinance is a regulatory action for the protection of natural resources and the environment and is therefore exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections 15307 and 15308.

Section 3. Severance Clause.

The Board declares that each section, sub-section, paragraph, sub-paragraph, sentence, clause, and phrase of this ordinance is severable and independent of every other section, sub-section, sentence, clause, and phrase of this ordinance. If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sub-paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase is held invalid, the Board declares that it would have adopted the remaining provisions of this ordinance irrespective of the portion held invalid and further declares its express intent that the remaining portions of this ordinance should remain in effect after the invalid portion has been eliminated.

Section 4. Publication.

A summary of this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper published in Marin County within fifteen days after its adoption.

Following a duly noticed public hearing, the foregoing ordinance was introduced at the regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Richardson Bay Regional Agency held on May 8, 2025, and was adopted by the following vote on July 10, 2025.
